Michelin-starred chef to open eatery in Miami's Midtown



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Rickshaw Hospitality is entering the South Florida market with Maska, an Indian restaurant that will be helmed by Executive Chef [Hemant Mathur](#).

Mathur is known for his Michelin-rated restaurants in New York City including Devi, which was the first Michelin-starred Indian restaurant in the U.S. His Manhattan eatery Tulsi also received a Michelin Star. Restaurateurs [Pravin Mascarenhas](#) and Shamsu Lalani are bringing Mathur's 30 years of tandoor cooking to 3252 Northeast 1st Ave. in Miami in January.

Initially, the 120-seat eatery will only be open for dinner and Sunday brunch. The 7,000-square-foot space can accommodate events and has a full-service bar serving specialty cocktails.

Maska will offer contemporary Indian dishes including octopus masala and lamb chops.
